

Project Description:

In late 2018 Howerton Engineering & Surveying was contracted by TSHD Architects to perform the civil engineering design on the proposed Rock Hill EMS Station #6 located next to the existing Rock Hill Elementary School. The project included the design of approximately 1,800 linear feet of 8" gravity sanitary sewer with 7 manholes and two horizontal bores and Ohio EPA permitting. 600 linear feet +/- of gas line was designed in order to service the proposed EMS. Howerton Engineering & Surveying developed a site design package to retro fit an existing parking lot to serve as the exit for the trucks out of the proposed EMS and a new entrance was designed off an existing roadway. A full grading and erosion control plan, stormwater management, pavement, sidewalk, site, and utility design were developed for this project. The total project cost is estimated at approximately \$500,000
