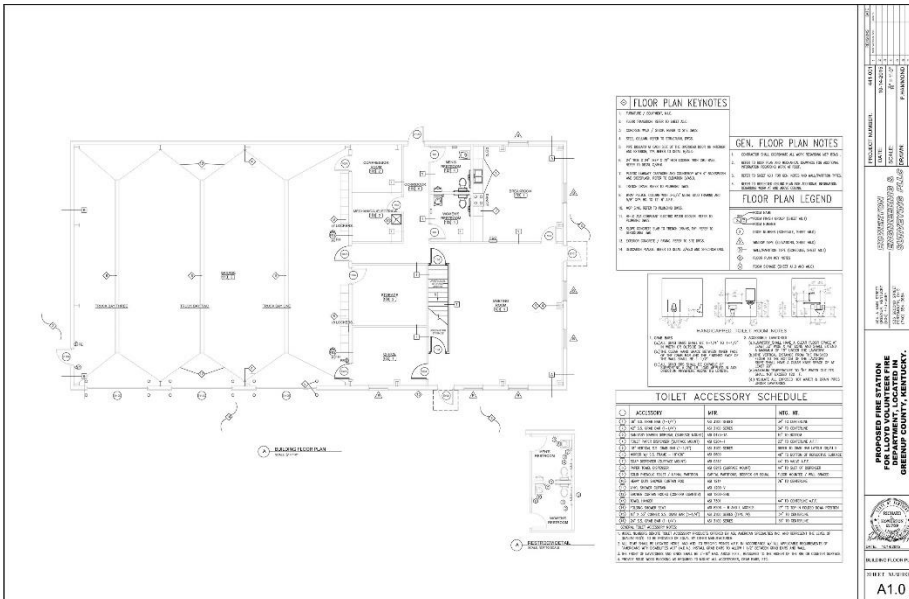


Lloyd Volunteer Fire Department New Fire Station/Community Center Greenup, Kentucky



Project Description:
In 2015, Howerton Engineering & Surveying was contracted by The Lloyd Volunteer Fire Department to design their proposed 50' x 100' 4 bay fire station. The proposed fire was erected beside the existing fire station. The fire department relocated all the fire equipment to the new fire station and the existing fire station was converted to a community center.

Howerton Engineering & Surveying prepared the building and site plans for the proposed fire station. The plans were submitted and obtained building permits along with permits from the county health department and DOT permits.
