

Meylan Special Services, Inc. Wurtland Office Building Design Wurtland, Kentucky



Project Description:

With Meylan Enterprises' Special Services expanding, the need for additional business offices and storage was required. In 2017 Meylan contracted Howerton Engineering and Surveying to design their proposed offices along with regrading the site for additional parking for office team members and company vehicles.

The design started with a full topographic of the proposed building site along with utility mapping and flow studies to determine if the existing system could handle the additional flow/demand of the proposed building.

A full building site package was prepared for Meylan. This package included a utility extension to provide the office with gas, water, sewer, and electrical service. The site was re-graded to provide adequate stormwater flow away from the building and into existing ditches that were redesigned to accommodate the additional flow.

The plans were submitted to the Greenup County Building Department and approved to construction in 2017.
