Project Description

In 2014 Howerton Engineering & Surveying was selected to perform the design and construction administration services for The City of Vanceburg's Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Project. The project included over 3,200 linear feet of sidewalk design, grading, drainage, and a pedestrian bridge.

The goal was to ensure the safety and efficiency of the local transportation system through effective guidance of the Local Public Agency. The specific steps to that end include preparation and development of plans, specifications, legal information and exhibits that facilitate your project's forward progression to a diverse set of professionals employed by the Cabinet on both the District and Central Office levels. Prior to construction, we determined the Right-of-Way sufficiency, Historic Preservation consistency and obtained the necessary environmental permits to move the project forward in accordance with the rules and regulations of both the Cabinet and the FHWA. In addition, temporary traffic control, traffic management, materials of construction and the testing methods thereof were all coordinated with diverse personnel within the Cabinet. The above was achieved using the LPA Guide and its Project Development Checklist (LPA-PDC).
